**Amor's Response to Current Border Closure Concerns: Updated 3/11/20**

While we believe a full shutdown of the US/Mexico border is highly unlikely, Amor is monitoring the situation very closely. Please note in the event of a closure, US citizens and non citizens with legal standing must be allowed to reenter the USA. Per the US Embassy, there are no policies and restrictions in place for entry and exit requirements, nor are there quarantine policies.

We will communicate with you proactively before you come to Mexico if it looks like the border will close. If it were to close, we would work with each group individually to figure out the best course of action.

We encourage groups to register in the STEP program with the State Department (<https://step.state.gov/step/>). The State Department would send alerts about any action at the border.
