COVID-19 Update – 3/29/20

As we continue through the uncertainty of the moment, please know you and your communities are in our prayers. Looking forward we want to make sure we are acting in the best interests of our partners while respecting current travel restrictions.

On March 19, 2020, the US State Department released a Level 4 Global Health Advisory restricting all travel with the stipulation: *If you choose to travel internationally, your travel plans may be severely disrupted, and you may be forced to remain outside of the United States for an indefinite timeframe.* With the possibility of groups not being able to return home and with respect to widespread shelter-in-place ordinances on both sides of the border, Amor is taking the following course of action:

- Amor will not be accepting new registrations for groups scheduled to arrive before May 21. Our hope is to host groups and serve alongside families in Mexico thereafter.
- As the May 21 date draws near, Amor will continue to use the most up to date information to determine if the May 21 date should be extended or rescinded. The factors bearing on this determination will be the status of the Global Health Advisory and the status of international travel restrictions.

Please continue to pray for our pastors and community leaders across the world who are needed as much as ever to minister to the needs of their communities.
